New binders were placed in each service areas and they, too, hold all the contact information, emergency codes, schedules, and important bulletins. Our HR has also scheduled workshops to review the Binder information and workshops on current Emergency procedures to ensure that our membership is up to date with current policies.

More than a 100 Volunteers from the Central East Region of Ontario will be our guests and learn about our hospital, our work here, and view our beautiful scenery. HAAO Spring Conference Needs YOU!


